- Crib
- Bassinette
- Mattress, waterproof pad
- Bedding/ linens
- Changing table

- Vaseline, Desitin, A and D ointment (No Baby Magic or other perfumed lotions)

- Baby bath tub
- Sun block, SPF \geq 15 for use after 4 months of age
- Bug-spray (10 - 30% DEET) on clothes only till one year of age.
- Hat
- Sunglasses that offer UVA and UVB protection
- Bibs/ "burp cloths"
- Baby bunting if (fall/winter)
- Receiving blankets
- T-shirts/ onesies
- Sleepers (Fleece and sleep sacks)
- Outfits
- Socks
- Hypoallergenic laundry detergent (Dreft)
- Car seat
- Car seat cover "Bundle Me"
- Head supporter insert
- Monitor – please do not watch your neighbors
- Cool mist humidifier
- Swing
- Bouncy seat
- Baby sling
- Stroller (Jogging Stroller)
- Breast pump
- Formula/ nursery water
- Bottles/nipples/ bottle brush
- Pacifiers
- Nail clippers, nail file or emery boards
- Bulb syringe
- Books (just because you can never have enough)
